



## **Private Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology Services**

Private Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology services are available throughout various parts of Newfoundland and Labrador. Public services are also available within schools, community health facilities, and hospitals.

Families and clients may choose to receive public or private services for different reasons. Each service may hold varying wait lists and waiting times.

Private services are offered on a fee-for-service basis, with costs determined by the individual professional. Please refer to our 'Private Practice Roster' on our website, [www.nlaslpa.ca](http://www.nlaslpa.ca), for a full listing of professionals offering services privately. Feel free to contact a professional directly to ask about potential wait times and costs.

In addition to assessment, treatment, and consultation, other billable services may include travel, report writing, meeting attendance, mileage, and/or miscellaneous expenses. It is ethical practice for a clinician to discuss fees and inform clients of the basis for billing, prior to service delivery.

Private services are not covered by the provincial health plan, but various insurance companies and/or other third party funding may cover portions of speech-language and audiology services. Call your insurance provider and ask what is covered for you and your family.

All Speech-Language Pathologists and Audiologists in Newfoundland and Labrador must be registered with the College of Audiologists and Speech-Language Pathologists of Newfoundland and Labrador (CASLP-NL) through the Newfoundland and Labrador Council of Health Professionals (NLCHP) in order to legally work in this province.
